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## **Publishing OSi geospatial data as Linked Data**

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### **Abstract**

Ordnance Survey Ireland (OSi) is Ireland's national mapping agency and is charged with managing authoritative geospatial information for the country. OSi has developed an object-centric relational database named Prime2 to facilitate management of this information. Prime 2 contains both open data (data freely available to anyone) and closed data (data not freely available or only available through purchase). In an initiative to make its open data more readily accessible and usable by third parties, OSi has adopted Linked Data practices to do so.

This poster presents OSi's Linked Data platform, available at <http://data.geohive.ie/>. The platform is designed to serve data for both human consumption and machine for inclusion in third party applications. Currently published on the platform is OSi's authoritative boundary datasets for counties, townlands, electoral districts, parishes and more at the resolutions of 100, 50 and 20 meters.
